

How to look for an Educational Interpreter who is certified through the New Hampshire Department of Education:

Go to The [New Hampshire Department of Education Bureau of Credentialing](#) website and click on [Educator Search](#). You will see the following screen:

Type the person's name in the First Name and Last Name fields and click Search.

If you want to bring up the list of all Educational Interpreters who are certified through the Department of Education, leave the First Name and Last Name fields blank. Click on the arrow to the right of the Select an Endorsement field and select *Educational Interpreter/Transliterator*.

You can perform the same search to look for a certified Teacher of the Deaf or a certified American Sign Language teacher

To look for a certified Teacher of the Deaf, choose *Deaf and Hearing Impaired* in the Select an Endorsement field.

To look for an ASL teacher, choose *American Sign Language* in the Select an Endorsement field.
